ACTIVITIES

- *A seminar on Adulteration in Sweets-* On 26th October 2018, Bhoomi held a seminar on adulteration in sweets. The guest lecturer was Dr. K M Chacko – Director of Shiram Institute for Industrial Research. A new issue was discussed of adulteration in sweets on occasion of festivals like Diwali, Dhanteras, etc.
- *A seminar on Sustainable Use of Waste-* On 27th March 2018, Bhoomi organised a seminar on the sustainable and effective use of waste and natural material for various productions. Pinki Masheshwari was the Chief Guest and speaker. She gave a lecture on “Why THROW when we can GROW”. She talked about her start-up of cotton based paper production. Her company has also made pencils from the waste newspapers and the same pencils could be grown into plants.

The eco club held a fest. Several competitions were hosted like photography and collage making competitions.

- *Workshop on Biodiversity conservation through ecological restoration-* On 30th October, 2017, Bhoomi organised a workshop on the mentioned topic. The lecture was delivered by the noted wildlife biologist Dr. Faiyaz A. Khudsar. The main aim of the workshop was to make the students aware of the deteriorating conditions of the environment and their ostensive role in future for its maintenance.
- *Anti-Cracker Campaign-* On 9th October 2017, when the Supreme Court banned the sale of firecrackers in Delhi and adjoining areas till 1st November, 2017. Following verdict the eco club organised an "Anticracker, Anti- noise and anti-pollution” rally on 17th October 2017 to spread awareness among the public on harmful effects of bursting crackers. They led the rally with the moto “Say no to crackers”.
